Since this is January of a new year, it's a good time to refresh everyone's knowledge of the NPU, Neighborhood Planning Unit. Berkeley Park is part of NPU-D, which is one of twenty-four NPUs operating throughout the city limits.

The NPU System was established to provide an opportunity for citizens to participate actively in the Comprehensive Development Plan (CDP): the City's vision for the next 5, 10, and 15 years. It is also used as a way for citizens to receive information concerning all functions of City government. The system enables citizens to express ideas and comment on City plans and proposals while assisting the City in developing plans which best meet the needs of different areas.

NPU-D meets on a monthly basis on the fourth (4th) Tuesday. The next meeting is on the 23rd of January. The meeting location is the Agape Community Center located on Bolton Road, .3 of mile south of the intersection of Bolton and Marietta Boulevard. Meetings start at 7:30. Membership is open to anyone 18 years or older whose primary residence is within the NPU, or any corporation, organization, institution or agency, which owns property or has a place of business or profession within the NPU.

An agenda is published for each meeting and is mailed to your home address. If you do not now receive the agenda, contact the Bureau of Neighborhood Conservation at 404.330.6190, fax at 404.658.7084, or Carl Smart, Director at eMail csmart@ci.atlanta.ga.us and ask them to place you on the mailing list.
